### BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION for-Aposte Jeroy H. Cannady, Sr.

- 1. He had one sister and three brothers (all who have preceded him in death).
- 2. He grew up in North Carolina.
- 3. He graduated from Popular Hill Elementary school.
- 4. He made the highest score on a standardized test given to all North Carolina students who planned to enroll in high school.
- 5. He is the father of 8 children.
- 6. While in high school, he got a job driving a school bus for eight dollars a month.
- 7. When he was around 10, he was an usher at Manassas Chapel Baptist Church.
- 8. On December 10, 1944, he married Virginia Parker (Mother Virginia Cannady).
- 9. He use to leave Baby Ruth candy bars in Mother Cannady's mailbox when they were dating.
- 10. He left North Carolina to come to Baltimore so that he could find a job to support his family.
- 11. After he rented a farmland in both Franklin and Granville, North Carolina for twelve years, he raised tobacco, cotton, corn, potatoes, and all kinds of produce for the market.
- 12. Around March of 1958, he became an employee of Bethlehem Steel at Sparrows Point, Md, paying \$100 a week.
- 13. Deacon John Person was his first roommate in 1957.
- 14. In 1956, he got his first job in Baltimore as a construction worker at Lawrence Construction Co., paying \$1.25/hr.



- 15. In 1934, after hearing Elder Chauncy Brooks (Way of the Cross Church of Christ) bring forth the word at a revival in Franklinton, he got baptized.
- 16. His favorite song to sing is"Jesus is On the Main Line".
- 17. He received the baptism of the Holy Ghost in 1935.
- He was ordained a deacon in 1935.
- 19. His first initial sermon was in 1949.
- 20. In his earlier years, he attended Ransom Way of the Cross Church in Franklinton.

- 21. His first official text came from Matthew 1:21—"She shall bring forth a Son and thou shall call his name Jesus".
- 22. He became a licensed Minister in 1950.
- 23. He was consecrated to the office of Bishop in 1970.
- 24. He was Diocesan Bishop (WOTCC, Intl') for South Carolina, Georgia, and Texas for 9 years.
- 25. He is part of the Apostolic Ministerial Alliance of Baltimore, MD and Washington, DC.
- 26. He founded the Baltimore Chapter of the Apostolic Christian College (ACC), a school founded by Bishop Alphonzo D. Brooks (Way of the Cross Church of Christ, Inc.- Mother Church).
- 27. He has recorded numerous tapes of his sermons.
- 28. He founded Refuge Way of the Cross Church of Christ, Inc in 1958.
- 29. He opened his first place of worship on 1352 North Calhoun Street in 1957.
- 30. He's birthed approximately 40 Sons in the Gospel.
- 31. He was consecrated as Presiding Bishop of the Way of the Cross Church of Christ, Intl' in 1985 and served through 2015.
- 32. He was consecrated as Apostle in 2016.






- 33. He received a Mayor's Citation (Baltimore, MD) award for "1979 Quality Contribution to Welfare of Municipality".
- 34. He received an award, "1983 Outstanding Community Service", from the Honorable Paren J. Mitchell, Congressman, 7<sup>th</sup> District of Baltimore, MD.
- 35. He received an award for "1986 Participation in Field Education Program" from Howard University, School of Divinity.
- 36. He received the "Man of the Year" award from Refuge Way of the Cross Church of Christ, Inc. on November 22, 1992.
- 37. In 1974, he received an award from the House of Representatives in Washington, D.C. for "Exceptional Prayer at the Opening Session of the U.S. House of Representatives".
- 38. He is the Founder of Theodore Barber Scholarship Foundation, Baltimore, Maryland.
- 39. On June 20, 1997, the City of Baltimore held a sign-mounting ceremony in which the corner of 43<sup>rd</sup> Street and Old York Road was designated Bishop Leroy H. Cannady Circle.
- 40. He studied Public Speaking at Dale Carnegie School, and grammar at the City College Preparatory School of Baltimore, Maryland.
- 41. On July 15, 1974, through the Honorable Parren J. Mitchell (a former member of the United States Congress), he gave the prayer at the Second Session of the 93<sup>rd</sup> Congress.
- 42. He established the Refuge Housing Project.








- 43. He's the author of the books, "Give Me This Mountain A Leap of Faith" and "Understanding the Holy Bible The Infallible Word of God".
- 44. He enrolled in the American Bible Institute for four years, studying Bible History, Techniques of Counseling and Applied Psychology, Practical Metaphysics and Church History, and other subjects.
- 45. He received the "Apostolic College" award.
- 46. He received an award for "1986 Exceptional Broadcasting Ministry Outstanding 25 Years of Church and Community Service" from WBGR Radio Station.
- 47. He had radio ministries on WBGR and WBMD Radio Stations Baltimore, Maryland, and WANN Radio Station, Annapolis, MD.
- 48. He published "Salvation, the Character and Nature of God" in May, 1985.
- 49. He recorded cassettes and videos, God Head, Water Baptism, Gifts of the Spirit, Salvation, and Faith and Works.






